

## Deloitte Tax summary of revenue proposals in FY 2023 White House budget blueprint available

The White House released a fiscal year 2023 budget blueprint on March 28 that echoes—and amplifies— President Joe Biden's longstanding calls for significant tax increases targeting large corporations and highincome individuals. All told, these revenue proposals would increase federal receipts by more than \$2.5 trillion (net) between 2023 and 2032, according to estimates from the Office of Management and Budget.
